The first Governor, John Graves Simcoe, inaugurated the proposal that a college or university should be erected, and his recommendation was supported by the Legislative Council and House of Assembly with a magnificent grant of land for which sanction was given by the Crown in 1798, but his real purpose was not to be realized in his own time nor indeed except through years of wearisome and precarious struggle. At last, however, the Provincial University became firmly established in Toronto, and it must always remain the peculiar creation and property of the people of this Province, who are bound to provide for their youth such education as will continue to be worthy of their progress in intelligence and wealth.
